

CHANGES FOR 2018-19

Be sure to *READ THE current TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR MANUAL* when it is sent out on or before September 1, 2018 to see these changes in more detail and learn how they will affect you.

Tournament System Change: The Keystone Region is changing event systems from AES to TM2Sign. All events will be entered and managed in that system instead of the Advanced Events Systems. The access for Tournament Directors will be pretty similar, but each TD will need a new account. The office is working out the contract and the details now, so we will have more details in the next few weeks. But TD's will not need to create accounts until later in the fall when the events are entered in the system and event info will need to be checked.

Again, we will keep you informed as we move forward.

Certificate of Insurance Requests: Previous years, TD's filled it a PDF and sent it back with the requested COI's. We will now have TD's submit an online COI request form. You will click on a link and fill out the form there for all dates and locations.

Officials Fees/Appendix I: This is an additional appendix that will be included in the new TD manual for 2018-19. The information is copied right from the KRVA General Operating Codes. This has been added to make the information more easily accessible for the TD's. You will find the "suggested minimum", match fees, etc. The chief referees often give TD's a breakdown of matches worked, but the TD can determine a set rate if they decide to. We recommend disclosing this information to the chief referee ahead of the event.
